

The 'An Alien in my Camera' prints were created from a single digital photograph by William, showing fungus found within an old film camera. The alien-like forms have been digitally abstracted by Michelle and printed by both artists using cyanotype. Rex's photos of Nellie's son Kyle, and the elephant, which was taken at the Melbourne Zoo, are full of detail and rich colours. The subjects are complimented and overlaid by Nellie's Lino mono print, bringing them together in a fluid and intricate way.





Rex Boggs


