WHAT WILL BE SHOWN?

- Each artist's work will respond to two unique words that have been chosen for them at random. It is up to each artist how they interpret their words and the form of their response. If you have not yet been assigned theme words contact the committee.
- One submission may consist of several related items, such as a triptych or series, provided that the items are intended to be sold as a single work.
- Large works or a second work from a participant are welcome dependent on available space. Any work larger than 900 x 900 mm wall space or 750 x 750 x 750 mm (3-D works) will require prior approval from the organising committee to ensure there is sufficient space.
- Work may be displayed framed or unframed and must be provided ready to be hung or displayed. Frames should have D-rings or a hanging wire on the back to allow hanging. Other works (eg unframed 2-dimensional work or 3-D works) must be accompanied by appropriate hanging materials (eg magnets). Some frames are available to borrow from Capricornia Printmakers Inc (CPI).
- Any questions about suitability, hanging, appropriate fees etc, should be directed to the Exhibition Committee as early as possible.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Members of CPI and other printmakers are invited to participate. Printmakers do not need to be a member of CPI to participate. Please feel free to forward this information to anyone you think may be interested in joining CPI or participating in this exciting exhibition.
- We invite teachers to encourage secondary and tertiary art students who work to a high standard to participate.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The work entered must be an original work of the submitting artist, completed within 12 months of the exhibition and not previously exhibited.
- Work must include a significant hand printed element.
- All works should be signed, dated and titled to CPI standards.
- All works should be accompanied by a Certificate of Authenticity which includes information about materials used.
- Art works will be exhibited at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.
- The exhibited artwork must be available for sale. 30% commission will be retained from the artist's sale price, 10% of which is paid to the RRC and 20% is retained by CPI.
- Whilst only one artwork will be exhibited per submission, opportunities will be available for the sale of additional editions of the work in a 'pop-up' shop in the CPI studio. Care should be taken to price further editions in line with the Exhibition work. CPI will retain 20% commission on work sold in the pop up shop.

PARTICIPATION FEES

For one submitted work (or series of related works):

- \$30 for CPI members
- \$25 for CPI Concessional Members and full time students
- \$45 for non-members

NOTE: Exhibition fee **does not include CPI membership** or studio fees. New members are always welcome, and annual fees are \$60.00 per year.
