This annual exhibition is an opportunity for CPI members to show their work to the public. Artists are encouraged to bring their own interpretation to the theme "About Time" using their preferred printmaking medium.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- All members of CPI are encouraged to participate by submitting a piece of work in line with the conditions of entry. A second piece may be submitted depending on available space.
- Printmakers who are not currently members of CPI may also submit work. Please feel free to forward this information to anyone you think may be interested in joining CPI or participating in this exciting exhibition.
- We invite teachers to encourage secondary and tertiary art students who work to a high standard to participate.
- Participants must submit an Intention to Exhibit form and pay the hanging fee by 1st
 September.

FEES

- \$10 hanging fee is required for each item exhibited by a CPI member
- \$45 hanging fee is required from printmakers who are not CPI members.
- Pay your participation fee by direct deposit online or at an Auswide bank.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The work entered must be:
 - o the original work of the submitting artist,
 - o include a significant hand printed element
 - o completed within 12 months of the exhibition and not previously exhibited.
- It is expected that exhibited work will be of a high standard and will use good quality paper, inks and other materials.
- All works should be signed, dated and titled to CPI standards and should be accompanied by a Certificate of Authenticity which includes information about materials used. Information about this is located on the CPI website under Resources.
- Work may be displayed framed or unframed and must be provided ready to be hung or displayed. 3-D works are welcome.
 - o Frames should have D-rings or a hanging wire on the back to allow hanging.
 - Other works (eg unframed 2-dimensional work or 3-D works) must be accompanied by appropriate hanging or display materials (eg magnets).
 - o Some frames are available to borrow from Capricornia Printmakers Inc (CPI).
- One submission may consist of several related items, such as a triptych or series, provided that the items are intended to be sold as a single work.
- Large works or a second work from a participant are welcome, dependent on prior approval from the organising committee to ensure there is sufficient space.
 A large work is any work larger than 900 x 900 mm wall space or 750 x 750 x 750 mm (3-D works).

Art works will be exhibited at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee. Any questions about suitability, hanging, appropriate fees etc, should be directed to the Exhibition Committee as early as possible.

SALES OF WORKS

- The exhibited artwork should preferably be available for sale.
- Additional editions of exhibited work can be placed in the Pop-up shop in the CPI studio.
 These should be priced in line with the exhibited piece.
- 20% commission will be retained from all sales in the gallery and the shop. Be sure to price your work to allow for this.

YOUR ASSISTANCE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THE EXHIBITION

- Exhibiting CPI members will be required to help with the organisation and preparations for this exhibition. Volunteers will be required for online and print promotions, preparation and catering for the opening night, installation of the works, cleaning the studio, etc. A list of tasks will be circulated.
- Exhibiting members will also be expected to help staff the exhibition during its run.
- Exhibitors who are not CPI members are not required to volunteer, although they are most welcome to participate in all activities.
